Refutations must be submitted to Child Care Services (CCS) within 10 business days of the completion date.

Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Your program must be Quality Rated by December 31, 2020 in order to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Sign up for Quality Rated by June 30, 2018 in order to be eligible to receive a bonus package.

Finding

591-1-1-.09(1)(g) requires Provisional Employees hired on or after January 1, 2014 to have a satisfactory Preliminary Records Check Determination. A Provisional Employee cannot reside at the Center or be present at the Center while children are present for care for more than 21 days from the date of hire or first day of residency without first submitting both a Fingerprint Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an authorized fingerprinting site. It was determined based on review of records that 3 staff members hired since July 18, 2018 do not have a satisfactory preliminary background check.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that Provisional Employees hired on or after January 1, 2014 have a satisfactory Preliminary Records Check Determination. The Center will have a plan to ensure that Provisional Employees hired on or after January 1, 2014 submit a Fingerprint Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an authorized fingerprinting site within 21 days from the date of hire or the first day of residency. The Center will not allow a provisional employee to be at the Center while children are present if this requirement is not met.
