Discussed-Fluff/Redistribute Surface and remove the grass from the resilient surfacing around the red slide.

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined, based on observation, in that five plastic flower pots along the back fence were observed to be cracked with sharp edges accessible to children on this date. It was further determined that a table was present on the playground with the top warped and separating from the based, causing a gap measuring one-half to one inch.

# POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
