Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all time and that the persons supervising in the child care area be alert, able to respond promptly to the needs and actions of the children being supervised, as well as the actions of the chaperones and Students-in-Training, and provide timely attention to the children's actions and needs. It was determined based on consultant's investigation regarding the three-year-old running out the classroom and out the building on Tuesday, August 1, 2017 was substantiated. Staff statements and interviews revealed the three-year-old child was observed to run out of the classroom and out the facility for less than a minute. Staff interviews revealed that the child has ran out the classroom before and the administrative team has intervened and returned him back to the classroom. Staff interviews and a statement via email from the parent that retained the child on the day of the incident revealed that the child was observed to exit the building and not the parking lot area. Consultant reviewed the video footage that reveals the three-year-old child exiting the classroom, down the hall and out the building before being escorted by a parent back in to the facility. This allegation is substantiated.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff and monitor to ensure they are providing supervision and watchful oversight to the children at all times.
