Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was determined based on a review of records that one child was observed to not have an up-to-date immunization record on file. The consultant observed the immunization record to have expired in January 2017.

The Home Provider will ensure that an immunization record/signed affidavit is on file for each enrolled Child.

Finding

It was determined based on review of records that the provider did not have documentation of arrival and departure times and the signature of the parent or authorized person for children enrolled.
