### **Finding Associated with Complaint**

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times and that the persons supervising in the child care area be alert, able to respond promptly to the needs and actions of the children being supervised, as well as the actions of the chaperones and Students-in-Training, and provide timely attention to the children's actions and needs. It was determined based on investigation findings, staff statements and staff interviews that a two-year-old had been bitten and staff was not aware that the child had been bitten. The parent of two-year-old child picked the child up in the afternoon and noticed that the child had a bite mark on the his back shoulder. The parent informed the staff of the bite mark on the child and showed the bite mark to staff who were unaware that the child had been bitten.

### **POI** (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff and monitor to ensure they are providing supervision and watchful oversight to the children at all times.
