Finding

591-1-1-.25(3) requires the Center and surrounding premises to be kept clean, free of debris and in good repair. Hygienic measures such as, but not limited to, screened windows and proper waste disposal procedures shall be utilized to minimize the presence of rodents, flies, roaches and other vermin at the Center. It was determined based on consultant observation that the following areas of the center need repaired:

- -the outside facia boards on the back of the building are rotten
- -on the right side leading out to the playground a piece of the building has rotten wood.
- -On the left side the wood that is not yellow leading out from the playground is chipping
- -The window seals throughout the halls walls have build-up dirt and dust
- -The corner of the diaper changing station in Room A is cracked. In addition, the wood that is attached to that area the nails need to be secured in and not loose.

The Center will have the Center and surrounding areas cleaned, make repairs where needed, and remove all debris is removed. The Center will implement a plan to keep areas clean and in good repair that includes regular monitoring.

591-1-1-.20(3) requires the Center to maintain a record of medication dispensed that includes the date, time and amount of medication, any noticeable adverse reaction, and the signature or initials of the person administering the medication. It was determined based on a review of records that a medication log stated that medication was due to be given to a child on August 10, 2017 and August 11, 2017 the log reflected the medication was given on August 10, 2017, but not August 11, 2017. It was further determined that medication was to be given from July 31, 2017 until August 5, 2017 and the medication was not given August 3, 2017 through August 5, 2017. In addition, medication was due to be given from July 23, 2017 until July 28, 2017 and the medication was not given on July 23, 2017.

The Center will train Staff responsible for dispensing medication in the accurate completion and storage of the records and will implement a plan to monitor this.
