If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

The coordinator and director discussed cutting all protruding bolts to two threads and capping the bolts if they expose sharp jagged edges. The Coordinator observed four bolts to protrude more than two threads by the entrances on and off the playground.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based upon the coordinators observation that the following pieces of equipment posed a potential hazard to the children in care: The pink slide on the Little Tikes climber was was cracked exposing sharp and jagged edges, the green dinosaur rocker was missing a left handle grip and a pink Cozy Coupe with a yellow top was missing a gas cap.
