If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Sleeping & Resting Equipment

Finding

591-1-1-.30(2)(c) requires that infants shall not sleep in equipment other than safety-approved cribs, such as, but not limited to, a car safety seat, bouncy seat, highchair, or swing. Infants who arrive at the Center asleep or fall asleep in such equipment, on the floor or elsewhere, shall be transferred to a safety-approved crib. It was determined based on staff statements and observation in classroom D an infant was allowed to sleep in a swing due to having severe reflux.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will only place infants in safe cribs to sleep and will transfer them to a safe crib when the infants are asleep in other equipment. Staff will obtain a note from the physician that will state what is needed for the specific infant concerning sleeping requirements.

Finding

591-1-1-.32(4) requires that children under three years old be housed in separate physical areas from older children and cannot be mixed with older children except at specified times and circumstances. It was determined based on observation that there were two, two-year-olds and five, three-year-olds in classroom A upon consultant's arrival. Further, it was determined based on observation that at naptime two, two-year-olds and five, three-year-olds were moved into the Pre-K classroom E for the remainder of the day.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will maintain separation of these children under three years old.
