B right side-girls bathroom had three tiles cracked.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that outdoor equipment be free of hazards such as lead-based paint, sharp corners, rust and splinters. It was determined based on observation that a potential hazard existed in that on the smaller blue climbing structure had rust present and the blue protective coating is cracking and coming off throughout the equipment.

To ensure the safety of equipment, the center will sand and repaint the equipment that is rusted and repair the blue protective coating.
