### **Comments**

An Administrative Review was conducted on October 14, 2020. Staff files, children's files, training, transportation documents, and background checks were all reviewed. A virtual inspection was conducted on October 16, 2020 from 12:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m. with the Director. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive Order issued on August 15, 2020 was reviewed during the virtual inspection. A copy of the COVID-19 Checklist was reviewed and sent to the Director.

An amendment application was sent to the Director to remove capacity limitations on classroom A due to cribs, as classroom A and B have now switched.

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
