### **Finding Associated with Complaint**

591-1-1-.15(6)(f) requires that hot food shall not be served at a temperature which would cause the children to burn their mouths upon consuming the food. It was determined during an incident investigation that a three-year-old child sustained a burn on her thigh area on October 7, 2020, after accidentally knocking over a cup of soup during lunch. It was unclear if medical attention was received.

### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that the temperature of foods is monitored to prevent a burn.
