

591-1-1-.25(17) requires that the Center premises be free of plants and shrubs which are poisonous or hazardous. It was determined based on observation that there were shrubs with berries on them and holly bushes accessible to the children on the playground.

### Comment

The provider is going to use cones to mark the space used outside by the children. The provider had submitted a Variance application for the playground not being fenced in. The application is under Department's review and the provider will be notified of the decision.

### Finding

591-1-1-26(8) requires climbing and swinging equipment to have a resilient surface beneath the equipment and the fall zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency. It was determined based on observation and measurements that the resilient surface in the fall zones of the six feet slide structure measured approximately two to three inches, when at least six inches are required.

### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will add additional resilient surfacing to the fall zones where needed and check daily, adding resilient surfacing as needed to maintain adequate resiliency.

Further, Consultant stated to Center Director and Owner, that prior to providing Transportation and/or Field Trips, the Center is required to consultant, to discuss and review all Transportation and Field Trip requirements.
