The purpose of this visit was to conduct a monitoring visit and follow up to the previous visit on April 25, 2019.


The consultant discussed communicable diseases, provider credentials and criminal records checks with the provider on this date.

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
