Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times and that the persons supervising in the child care area be alert, able to respond promptly to the needs and actions of the children being supervised, as well as the actions of the chaperones and Students-in-Training, and provide timely attention to the children's actions and needs. It was determined based on information received during the investigation that on October 30, 2018, watchful oversight was not provided by a staff person who was physically present in the older two-year-old classroom. A two-year-old child was running to and from the back door to the book shelves with a toy truck. The child slid into the book shelf causing an injury to the mouth and tooth. The staff person admitted she was unable to provide details of how the child sustained the injury because she did not observe the incident. The two-year-old child required professional medical attention.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff and monitor to ensure they are providing supervision and watchful oversight to the children at all times.
