If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was determined based on observations that the following items were in need of repair:

-In the back left classroom a small hole, peeling wet paint was observed on the lower back left corner wall

- two ceiling tiles were missing near the front door

### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will have the Center and surrounding areas cleaned, make repairs where needed, and remove all debris is removed. The Center will implement a plan to keep areas clean and in good repair that includes regular monitoring.

#### **Finding**

Previously Cited: 591-1-1-.26(7) requires that climbing and swinging equipment be anchored and have a resilient surface beneath the equipment. The fall-zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that mulch under the metal slide and the green swings measured less than one inch in depth.

591-1-1-.26(8) requires climbing and swinging equipment to have a resilient surface beneath the equipment and the fall zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency. It was determined based on observation that mulch in the fall zones of the swings measured less than six inches.

## POI (Plan of Improvement)

The director states that she has order more mulch and it scheduled to arrive on Wednesday November

8, 2017. The Center will add additional resilient surfacing to the fall zones where needed and check daily, adding resilient surfacing as needed to maintain adequate resiliency.
