- 2) Your name, title/relationship to the facility, e-mail address & up to two phone number(s) where you can be reached
- 3) Specific rule number(s) that you are refuting, along with your concerns or questions regarding the rule citation

Refutations must be submitted to Child Care Services (CCS) within 10 business days of the completion date.

Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Your program must be Quality Rated by December 31, 2020 in order to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Sign up for Quality Rated by June 30, 2018 in order to be eligible to receive a bonus package.

Finding

591-1-1-.06(4) requires a Center first licensed after March 1, 1991, and Centers that remodel or add to existing plumbing facilities, to have the bathroom area fully enclosed and ventilated to the outside of the building with either an open screened window or functioning exhaust fan and duct system and requires Centers without fully enclosed bathrooms to ensure there is adequate ventilation to control odors and adequate sanitation measures to prevent the spread of contagious diseases. It was determined based on consultant's observation that the exhaust fans in the boys and girls bathrooms were not functioning.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will fully enclose and ventilate bathroom areas, as required, and will provide adequate ventilation and sanitation in bathrooms that are not fully enclosed..

Finding

591-1-1-.09(1)(g) requires Provisional Employees hired on or after January 1, 2014 to have a satisfactory Preliminary Records Check Determination. A Provisional Employee cannot reside at the Center or be present at the Center while children are present for care for more than 21 days from the date of hire or first day of residency without first submitting both a Fingerprint Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an authorized fingerprinting site. It was determined based on review of records that this information was not on file for one staff person. A one day letter was left on this date.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that Provisional Employees hired on or after January 1, 2014 have a satisfactory Preliminary Records Check Determination. The Center will have a plan to ensure that Provisional Employees hired on or after January 1, 2014 submit a Fingerprint Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an authorized fingerprinting site within 21 days from the date of hire or the first day of residency. The Center will not allow a provisional employee to be at the Center while children are present if this requirement is not met.

591-1-1-.33(3) requires each staff member with direct care responsibilities to complete health and safety training at the time of employment that will count toward required annual training: Staff employed prior to September 30, 2016 will complete the training by December 29, 2016 and Staff employed after September 30, 2016 will complete the health and safety training within the first 90 days of employment. It was determined based on review of records that this information was not documented for three staff members.
