If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

591-1-1-.25(13) requires that hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be inaccessible to children. It was determined based on consultant's observation that a tube of destin cream, two bottles of sunscreen, two tubes of diaper cream, and two bottles of magic stick diaper balm were located in the far left girls bathroom at the end of the facility's hallway on a lower right shelve accessible to children.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the safe storage of hazardous items, the center will store hazardous items out of reach of children.

Finding

591-1-1-.25(3) requires the Center and surrounding premises to be kept clean, free of debris and in good repair. Hygienic measures such as, but not limited to, screened windows and proper waste disposal procedures shall be utilized to minimize the presence of rodents, flies, roaches and other vermin at the Center. It was determined based on consultant's observation that the third stall in the girls bathroom on back left had a cracked tank top on the left side. It was also determined that the first two stalls in girls bathroom had missing protective caps on the base of the toilets. It was further determined that the boys bathroom on left side of hallway had two protective caps missing on the middle stall on the base of the toilets.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will have the Center and surrounding areas cleaned, make repairs where needed. The Center will implement a plan to keep areas clean and in good repair that includes regular monitoring.
