Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.25(12) requires heating and cooling equipment to be protected to prevent children from touching it. Fans, space heaters, etc. shall be positioned or installed so as to be inaccessible to the children. It was determined during an investigation that on undetermined dates on the week of November 13, 2017, space heaters were used to supplement the central heat. Based on staff statements a heater was plugged in on the rear left side of room A and sat on the floor near the cots and was blocked by a child size chair, as well as staff stated children were not allowed to access the area. It was determined that the chair was no sufficient to prevent children from touching the heater. Based on the observation this date, a space heater was stored on the floor in another corner classroom A .The heater was not in use.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will re-position or re-install equipment, as needed, and will make all such equipment inaccessible to children or remove equipment from the classroom.
