591-1-1-.12(4) requires that equipment and furniture is secured if it is of a weight or mass that could cause injury from tipping, falling, or being pulled or pushed over. It was determined based on investigative findings that on November 27, 2018, a six-year-old child sustained a broken toe as a result of knocking over a bookshelf onto their toe.

The Center will ensure that the identified equipment or furniture and any other such existing or future items are secured adequately and will have a system for checking these for stability.
