This Licensing Study is the first regulatory visit for Akim Academy this 2018 - 2019 fiscal year.

The center does not provide liability insurance, administers medication, does not provide field trips or routine transportation.

The center is currently working with the Quality Rated Program.

The consultant reviewed all staff files and finds that one staff member has a national satisfactory fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file. This letter is associated with a different CCLC and not the current CCLC of employment. A one-day letter was left with the center director.

It was determined based on the consultant's observation and review of all staff files that one staff member was hired on August 4, 2017, has a satisfactory national on file however, no comprehensive fingerprint criminal records clearance determination on file as required. The satisfactory national letter is on file at a different CCLC for this staff member and was not ported to this CCLC. A one-day letter was left with the center director.
