
- 1) Facility name, license number and visit date

Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Finding

591-1-1-.31(13) requires that Center Staff shall not commit any criminal act, as defined under Georgia law, in the presence of any child enrolled in the Center and shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations. Georgia law (O.C.G.A. Section 50-36-1) requires applicants for a public benefit, such as a license, to provide proof of lawful presence in the United States. A review of records determined that verification of lawful presence was not received for this center by the due date of Dec 21, 2019.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The required verification of lawful presence documents will be submitted no later than Dec 22, 2019. The Department will begin the process to issue a notice of license revocation if the verification of lawful presence documents are not received by Jan 21, 2020.
