Finding

Previously Cited: 591-1-1-.26(8) requires the playground to be kept clean, free of litter and hazards. It was determined that based on observations that several hazards existed on the playgrounds on this date. On the Pre-K playground, a plastic tarp was exposed in the sand box and the white plastic boarder around the small garden was broken. On middle playground, rust was observed on a tricyle and a large trap covering the sand box was dirty and had leaves in the sand box.

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that several small active ant beds was present under the easel on the Pre-K playground.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the playground, the center will treat and monitor for ant beds. The center treated the area during the visit.
