- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. 591-1-1-25(13) requires that potentially hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be stored in a locked area inaccessible to children. It was determined based on Consultant observation that the closets were unlocked in the two-year-old classroom and the Preschool classroom and there was a teachers backpack, a can of Lysol and a spray bottle with cleaning solution present on the floor of the closets and were accessible to children. Further there were large rolls of bulletin board paper present in the Preschool classroom and the School Age Classroom and a fall hazard was posed.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.

# 591-1-1-.26 Playgrounds(CR)

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on Consultant observation that the deck that children access the playground with had three center posts that had fallen off the deck and were present on the playground and had nails present. Further there were nails backed out of the two wooden play structures. Also the fence area that surrounded the gas meter had a broken cap with sharp edges present and the left side of the fence was no longer attached to the fence and the end cap wasn't covered and was sharp.

#### **POI** (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
