## Finding

.

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that the concrete ground was cracked and had exposed sharp edges on the left back side on the playground. It was further determined that there was uneven surfacing between the concrete ground and soft ground causing a potential tripping hazard on the left back side of the playground.

**POI (Plan of Improvement)** The center will add more dirt around the concrete platform and repair cracks to prevent tripping. The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
