If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

591-1-1-.26 Playgrounds(CR)

Finding

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observation that a blue and orange plastic slide structure was observed to be cracked with the potential for pinching.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will provide a variety of age-appropriate equipment that is arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters. The director stated that she will remove the slide structure. Discussed regarding keeping an eye on the S hooks on the swings and be sure to tighten.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that on the following hazards were observed on the playgrounds:

-PG Front Right: There was a five and a half inch gap at the bottom of the gate leading to the parking lot and street area on the right side. The mulch was also observed to be washed away along the walkway creating a tripping hazard and concrete was also exposed near the area.

-PG 2nd Left: A dark substance was observed on the white PVC piping in three areas on the playground. Fallen tree branches were also observed throughout the playground area.

-PG Middle: Fallen tree branches were observed near the shed area on the playground.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards. Maintenance who was present during the visit, utilized bleach to remove the black substance from the PVC piping during the visit. The consultant also discussed regarding keeping an eye on the green substance beginning to grow on the building and have it cleaned.

It was determined based on observation that the mats in the 1st Left, Left 1st Right, Left Back Right, and Right Front-Left classrooms were observed to be torn

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that cots and mats are of sound construction and of sufficient size to accommodate the size and weight of the child and mats are in good repair, washable, covered with a waterproof material and is at least two inches thick. The staff will utilize tape as a temporary fix until the mats can be replaced.
