Comments

Due to COVID-19 no in person visit was completed. An Administrative Review was completed on 08-05-2021 and a Virtual Visit was completed on 08-09-2021. The center director stated she has a total of 6 staff with 2 staff being new hires since the last visit. No medication is administered, no field trips or routine transportation is provided. The consultant observed two large white tents to be installed on the playground, one on each playground, for shade and observed them to be well anchored. Additionally, the playground on the left had a shelter built over the swings for shade. The center director stated she used STABLE money to add all of the shading on the playgrounds. Additionally, she stated she used money to stock the center for PPE Supplies and classroom materials as well as paid her staff when they needed to be off work for themselves or immediate family members for COVID-19. The center director stated she was very appreciative to the STABLE money and reported this being a life safer to keeping her business open.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
