### 591-1-1-.26 Playgrounds(CR)

### Finding

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on observation that the following areas of the fence on the "soccer field" were not in good repair:

- Main entrance gate at the bottom of the stairs: a gap measuring five and one half inches was present between the gate and the fence post, causing a potential entrapment hazard

-Main entrance gate on the bottom right side of the stairs: a gap measuring four to five inches was present between the gate and the fence post, causing a potential entrapment hazard

-Gate leading to the front parking lot: a gap measuring six to seven inches was present at the bottom on the gate, causing a potential entrapment hazard

### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and remains at least 4 feet high, and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards and to keep the fence gates closed when not in use.
