Finding

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined, based on observations, that several equipment hazards were present on this date. The seat was missing and broken plastic with sharp edges was exposed on a Doc McStuffins riding toy. The plastic on the side of a small red and black riding toy was cracked with sharp exposed edges. The front metal tire covering was rusted on one tricycle. The back left tire of a power wheels toy was cracked and had sharp edges exposed.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will remove the cited items. Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined, based on observations, that there were five or more active ant beds present in the play area.
