

Refutations must be submitted to Child Care Services (CCS) within 10 business days of the completion date.

Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. 591-1-1-.25(3) requires the Center and surrounding premises to be kept clean, free of debris and in good repair. Hygienic measures such as, but not limited to, screened windows and proper waste disposal procedures shall be utilized to minimize the presence of rodents, flies, roaches and other vermin at the Center. It was determined based on observation that there was a baseboard missing under the changing table in classroom R4, creating a gap measuring less than 5 inches.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will have the Center and surrounding areas cleaned, make repairs where needed, and remove all debris is removed. The Center will implement a plan to keep areas clean and in good repair that includes regular monitoring.

Finding

591-1-1-.20(3) requires the Center to maintain a record of medication dispensed that includes the date, time and amount of medication, any noticeable adverse reaction, and the signature or initials of the person administering the medication.

It was determined based on review of records that medication was authorized to be dispensed from April 3. 2018 to April 4, 2018, however, the medication log did not indicate that the medication was dispensed beyond April 6, 2018.

It was determined that medication was authorized to be dispensed from March 21, 2018 to April 4, 2018 three times per day, however the medication log did not indicate that medication was dispensed two times per day on March 21, 2018, March 27, 2018, and April 4, 2018 and once per day on March 22, 2018, March 23, 2018, April 2. 2018 and April 3. 2018.

It was determined that medication was authorized to be dispensed from April 9, 2018 to April 13, 2018 at 11:30 AM and 3:15 PM, however, the medication log did not indicate that medication was dispensed at 11:30 AM on April 11, 2018 and April 12, 2018.

It was determined that medication was authorized to be dispensed from April 23, 2018 to May 4, 2018 at 12:30 PM and 4:30 PM, however, the medication log did not indicate that medication was dispensed at 4:30 PM on April 25, 2018 and 12:30 PM on April 26, 2018.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff responsible for dispensing medication in the accurate completion and storage of the records and will implement a plan to monitor this.
