- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.03(8) requires a center to provide individual attention to each child by responding promptly to the child's distress signals and need for comfort. It was determined based on investigative findings that on August 28, 2019, staff failed to console a three-year-old child who was crying from an injury to the head.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will provide staff training in when and how to respond appropriately to children's distress signals and need for comfort.

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.25(19) prohibits the use of unapproved areas for children's activity. It was determined based on investigative findings that on August 28, 2019, staff members allowed children to participate in activities in the hallway, which was an unapproved and unlicensed area.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will discontinue use of this area.
