- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. A variety of equipment and toys were observed throughout the center.

Finding

591-1-1-.12(2) requires that all equipment and furniture be free from hazardous conditions such as, but not limited to, sharp rough edges or toxic paint; and be kept clean. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that the dramatic play boat pillow in the one year old class was not in good repair in that the white pole had a tear on the top sections with exposed foam. It was further determined based on the consultant's observation that the yellow smart chair had a sharp edge located on the middle part of the chair accessible to children.

Finding

591-1-1-.10(4) requires that if diapers are changed on a diaper changing surface, the surface shall be smooth, nonporous, and equipped with a guard or rails to prevent falls. Between each diaper change, the diaper changing surface shall be cleaned with a disinfectant and dried with a single-use disposable towel. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that the staff member in the one year old classroom did not clean the diaper changing surface with a disinfectant and dried with a single-use disposable towel after diapering.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure there is a smooth, nonporous changing surface that has a guard or rails for safety in each classroom that houses children wearing diapers. Center Staff will be trained and have adequate supplies to properly clean the diaper changing surface between each diaper change.

There shall be continuous watchful oversight of the vehicle between the first check and second check. It was determined based on the consultant's review that on November 30,2018 for the afternoon route from Coastal Empire Montessori, the center did not document a second check of the vehicle. It was further determined based on the consultant's review that on December 18, 2018, for the morning afternoon route from Haven Elementary, the center did not document a second check of the vehicle. It was further determined based on the consultant's review that on December 19, 2018 for the morning and afternoon route from the center and from Haven Elementary the center did not document a second check of the vehicle. It was further determined based on the consultant's review that on December 19, 2018 for the morning route to Gould Elementary the center did not document a second check of the vehicle. It was further determined based on the consultant's review that on January 4, 2019 for the afternoon route from East Broad Street Elementary School the center did not document the second check of the vehicle.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff who are or may be involved in transporting children in how to thoroughly inspect a vehicle and properly complete transportation documentation. The Center will review and monitor.
