- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance

#### **Finding Associated with Complaint**

591-1-1-.15(6)(f) requires that hot food shall not be served at a temperature which would cause the children to burn their mouths upon consuming the food. It was determined based on an investigation that on October 26, 2020, a one-year-old child sustained blisters to the child's fingers on the child's right hand, when the child placed the child's hand in a bowl of mashed potatoes. Medical attention was provided as a precaution.

### **POI** (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that the temperature of foods is monitored to prevent a burn.
