Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Staffing and Supervision

591-1-1-.32 Staff: Child Ratios and Group Size(CR)

Finding

591-1-1-.32(2) requires the Center maintain Staff:child ratios in mixed-age groups based on the age of the youngest group of children that includes more than twenty percent of the total number of children in the mixed-age group. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that a ratio of 2:13 was maintained in the infant classroom (Classroom A - Middle Building). 3 of the children were identified by staff as being one year of age with the remaining children identified as infants under the age of one year. A ratio of 3:13 was required. . Based on the consultant's observation at ratio of 2: 44 was maintained in the front building when 22 three and four year old children were maintained in the space with 22 school age children. A ratio of 3:44 was required .

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will provide adequate staff when there is a mixed-age group. Immediate correction required. During the visit the owner came in to provide addition supervision, however, the center required additional staff. It was discussed that the center required substitutes for emergencies.
