#### Finding

591-1-1-.03(2) requires the Center to keep current lesson plans on site that reflect appropriate instruction practices and activities to support children's development The Center shall have sufficient and varied play and learning equipment and materials to support the above program of activities in all developmental areas. It was determined based on consultant observation that classrooms did not have current lesson plans. Plan in the 2L room were posted and observed to be from August and September 2017.

The Center will keep current lesson plans on site that include appropriate instruction practices and activities and will have sufficient and varied play and learning equipment and materials to support the activities.

591-1-1-.25(3) requires the Center and surrounding premises to be kept clean, free of debris and in good repair. Hygienic measures such as, but not limited to, screened windows and proper waste disposal procedures shall be utilized to minimize the presence of rodents, flies, roaches and other vermin at the Center. It was determined based on consultant observation that the following items are in need of repair:

-center wall paint throughout was observed to be chipping

-ceiling in the kitchen has a brown ring and is chipping the popcorn

-wall behind the toilet in the restroom for 1R and 2R had sharp edges

-the blue middle wall in the restroom in between 1R and 2R was chipping plaster and paint.

-the corner of the 2nd post in the back building was chipping plaster and paint

-kitchen counter above the dishwasher was cracked.

### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will have the Center and surrounding areas cleaned, make repairs where needed, and remove all debris is removed. The Center will implement a plan to keep areas clean and in good repair that includes regular monitoring.

Containers for food storage other than the original container or package in which the food was obtained shall be impervious and non-absorbent, have tight-fitting lids or covers and labeled as to contents. It was determined based on consultant observation that several items were found to not be in the original container and not labels as to their contents. Consultant observed breakfast cereal on the kitchen counter, a ziploc bag in the door, items in the kitchen freezer, leftover items in the refrigerator, and cookies in the pantry to not be labeled.

# POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will designate an appropriate area for the storage of containers of food, will make available containers, lids, and covers, and will train Staff on proper storage and labeling.
