- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was determined based on observation the following hazards were accessible on the playgrounds on this date: Playground B - there was ripped plastic ground covering under the stick tee-pee, the red barn had chipping paint and rotting wood exposed, two hoses were looped and accessible, there were two straps tied loosely to trees, and five screens had holes present in the material. Playground C (building 2) - two window screens had holes present in the material.

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.

The program's owner or an officer/member of the corporation must view the A to Z Background Check video units pertaining to this records check rule and return the signed affidavit within one week from this visit date. The Center will ensure all students in training, volunteers and other present at the center submit an application and fingerprints to the department before being on site, to ensure the CRC rules are maintained.

The program's owner or an officer/member of the corporation must view the A to Z Background Check video units pertaining to this records check rule and return the signed affidavit within one week from this visit date. The center will ensure all students in training, employees and volunteers receive a comprehensive comprehensive records check determination letter prior to being present at the center, to ensure the CRC rules are maintained.
