An Administrative Review was conducted on October 16, 2020. Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. A virtual inspection was conducted on October 15, 2020 with the Director. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive Order issued on May 12, 2020 was reviewed during the virtual inspection.

Additional cleaning and sanitizing requirements due to the COVID-19 pandemic were also discussed and observed during a virtual walk through on this date.

Consultant emailed FAQs for Revised Rules, Chocking Handout and Required Reported Communicable Disease list.

 Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee



If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
