POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will ensure that each crib has an individual, tight-fitting sheet which is changed daily or more often as needed and prior to a change of occupant. The director reported that new crib sheets were ordered and should arrive by July 18, 2019. However, the director reported that the center would purchase safety straps that would be placed underneath the sheets to pull the sheets tight to ensure the sheets are tight-fitting as required until the new sheets arrive.
