- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

- •Classroom 104: A box of gloves were observed accessible to children in the drawer under the diaper changing table.
- •Classroom 105: A box of paper clips, a string of lights, and three boxes of gloves were observed accessible to children in the drawer under the counter.
- •Classroom 106: Three boxes of gloves were observed accessible to children in the drawer under the counter.
- •Classroom 121: A glue gun and a plastic grocery bag were observed accessible to children in the drawer under the counter. Two pairs of adult scissors and a bottle of Body Fantasies Body Spray was found accessible to children in an unlocked cabinet in the classroom.
