Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Finding

591-1-1-.06(4) requires a Center first licensed after March 1, 1991, and Centers that remodel or add to existing plumbing facilities, to have the bathroom area fully enclosed and ventilated to the outside of the building with either an open screened window or functioning exhaust fan and duct system and requires Centers without fully enclosed bathrooms to ensure there is adequate ventilation to control odors and adequate sanitation measures to prevent the spread of contagious diseases. It was determined based on observation that the following exhaust fans were observed to be operable on this date:

- *Classroom two boys bathroom exhaust fan not operable
- * Classroom four girls and boys bathroom exhaust fans not operable
- *Classroom seven girls and boys bathroom exhaust fans not operable
- *Classroom eight girls bathroom exhaust fan not operable
- *Classroom ten girls bathroom exhaust fan not operable

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will fully enclose and ventilate bathroom areas, as required, and will provide adequate ventilation and sanitation in bathrooms that are not fully enclosed.

Finding

591-1-1-.25(13) requires that potentially hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be stored in a locked area inaccessible to children. It was determined based on observation that skin protectant cream was observed on the diapering changing table in classroom three which was accessible to children on this date. The consultant further observed child body wash in an unlocked cabinet under the diaper table in classroom three on this date.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.

Finding

591-1-1-.25(8) requires protective caps on all unused electrical outlets within children's reach and requires that electrical outlets in use be made inaccessible to children. It was determined based on observation that a multi-outlet in classroom three was observed to have outlets that were not in use uncovered on this date.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff to check outlets and replace protective caps when needed and identify and monitor how outlets in use are inaccessible to children.

The director stated that the equipment is not used at this time and will not be used until a decision is made regarding the equipment. The director will notify the consultant and provide pictures once a decision is made regarding the slide equipment.
