Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was determined based on consultant's observation the toilet in the first right restroom located in the Discovers classroom was inoperable on this date.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will have the center and surrounding areas cleaned, make repairs where needed, and remove all debris is removed. The center will implement a plan to keep areas clean and in good repair that includes regular monitoring. The center is aware that the toilet in the first right restroom located in the Discovers classroom is inoperable, but the center is waiting on a specific part to be delivered to ensure the toilet is completely repaired.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on consultant's observation several small ant mounds were observed on the middle side of the playground area and next to the rubber resilient surface behind the swing set located on playground B-5-12 yrs. It was further determined based on consultant's observation that a small ant mound was observed directly in front of the rubber resilient surface surrounding the bucket swings on playground A-6wks-2 yrs.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards daily. The center will also ensure that staff members report any hazardous items observed on the playground to the center management team as needed.

591-1-1-.09 Criminal Records Check(CR)

Technical Assistance

Technical Assistance

Consultant discussed the following criminal records check rule changes with the director on this date:

- Local background checks (with purpose code "W") will no longer be accepted (no more 21-day provisional employment).
- Everyone must have at least a fingerprint-based background check letter before they can be present at the center to care for children.
- The new definition of Provisional Employee includes those with only a satisfactory Fingerprint Records Check Determination. People with this type of clearance are allowed on site, but must be under the direct and continuous supervision of a Director or Employee with a satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination.
- A new comprehensive background check must be run for anyone who has had a lapse of employment in the child care industry that lasts 6 months or longer. (Students-in-Training are considered "employed in the child care industry" if they've been enrolled in a child care related curriculum.)
- Letters will only be accepted at a new facility if they are "ported" electronically.

Comment

Consultant reviewed 25 staff files on this date. Consultant observed 25 of 25 staff members to have evidence of a satisfactory determination letter on file on this date.

Comment

The director provided 10 files for staff members hired since the previous visit was conducted on June 19, 2018. Consultant observed 10 of 10 newly hired staff members to have evidence of a satisfactory determination letter on file.

591-1-1-.14 First Aid & CPR Not Met

Finding

591-1-1-.14(2) requires a Staff member who is trained in CPR and first aid to be on the premises and on any field trip whenever any child is present. In addition, Staff who provide direct care to children must satisfactorily obtain certification in first aid and CPR by December 29, 2016 if employed prior to September 30, 2016 and within 90 days of their hire date if employed after September 30, 2016. It was determined based on consultant's review of staff files two of 25 staff members did not have evidence of a current first aid and CPR training card on file on this date.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will develop a schedule to ensure there is always a staff person with current first aid and CPR training present and will develop and implement a plan to ensure all staff members have satisfactorily completed first aid and CPR training by the specified date. Per director, the center has scheduled a first aid and CPR training for August 21, 2018. Upon completing the required training, all staff members will provide the director a copy of their first aid and CPR training card to be placed in their staff file.

Finding

591-1-1-.33(3) requires each staff member with direct care responsibilities to complete health and safety training at the time of employment that will count toward required annual training: Staff employed prior to September 30, 2016 will complete the training by December 29, 2016 and Staff employed after September 30, 2016 will complete the health and safety training within the first 90 days of employment. It was determined based on consultant's review of staff files two of 25 staff members did not complete the required health and safety orientation training within 90 days of their date of hire.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will develop and implement a plan to schedule and track this training for all employees based on their hire dates. Upon completing the required health and safety orientation training the center will ensure all staff members provide a copy of their certificate to the director to be placed in their staff file.
