If the Director is absent from the Center at any time during the hours of the Center's operation, there shall be an officially designated person on the Center site to assume responsibility for the operation of the Center, and this person shall have full access to all records required to be maintained under these rules. It was determined based on observation that there was no Director on the premises when Consultant arrived. Additionally, there was not a designated person at the Center to assume responsibility for the operation of the Center is unavailable.

The Center will ensure a director, responsible for the supervision, operation and maintenance of the Center is on the premises. during operating hours. The Center will officially designate a person to assume responsibility for the operation of the Center when the director is not present who has full access to all records.

Finding

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times and that the persons supervising in the child care area be alert, able to respond promptly to the needs and actions of the children being supervised, as well as the actions of the chaperones and Students-in-Training, and provide timely attention to the children's actions and needs. It was determined based on observation that one staff member in Main C Two Year Old room left the classroom to answer the front door to let Food Program Specialist and Consultant inside while leaving the staff member in Main D Infant and One Year Old room to supervise both classrooms by standing in the joining door of the two rooms. Additionally, one Staff member in Main D left the classroom unsupervised for less than one minute to take a bowl of mash potatoes to classroom Main A.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff and monitor to ensure they are providing supervision and watchful oversight to the children at all times.
