## **Finding**

Previously Cited: 591-1-1-.33(4) requires ten clock hours of annual training for supervisory and caregiver staff in the subjects of early childhood education, child development or subjects related to the position. It was determined based on observation of staff files that annual training was not complete for all staff in license year 2016.

591-1-1-.33(6) requires, in the first year of employment and then by calendar year thereafter, all supervisory and caregiver Personnel, except independent contractors, Students-in-Training and volunteers to attend ten (10) clock hours of training which is task-focused in early childhood education or child development or subjects relating to job assignment and is offered by an accredited college, university or vocational program or other Department-approved source. It was determined based on the observation of staff records that ten hours of 2017 training was not on file.
