If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was determined based on review of records, that staff # 2, # 19 and # 22, all hired on September 1, 2019 as substitutes, did not have a valid and current satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on file prior to being present at the Center while any child is present for care. A one day letter was left.
