Previously Cited: 591-1-1-17(7)(a-d) requires that children wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival for care, when moving from one child care group to another, upon re-entering the child care area after outside play, before and after eating meals and snacks, handling or touching food, playing in water; after toileting and diapering, playing in sand, touching animals or pets, and contact with bodily fluids; after contamination by any other means. It was determined based on observation that children did not wash their hands upon arrival to the center.

It was determined based on observation that four children did not wash their hands upon arrival to cafeteria where the Pryme Tyme program is housed.
