## Comments

This Licensing Study is the first regulatory visit for Wilkinson Head Start this 2018 - 2019 fiscal year. The center currently has a two-star Quality Rating. The center provides liability insurance, does not administer medication, noes not provide field trips or routine transportation.

The consultant reviewed all staff files and finds that each member has a satisfactory comprehensive fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. 591-1-1-.25(13) requires that potentially hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be stored in a locked area inaccessible to children. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that in classroom A, antibacterial medication was stored in a storage cabinet with a broken lock in the bathroom on the left. making it accessible to the children in care. Additionally, in classroom B a broom and dust pan was stored beside the sand table next to the black storage cabinet and was accessible to the children in care.

# POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.

# 591-1-1-.26 Playgrounds(CR)

## Finding

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that the fencing on the right front side of the playground had a broken and rusted pole leaving a two by one inch rusted hole with sharp edges. Additionally, one of two six foot gate panels is loose from the bottom pole causing the fencing panel to be unsecured.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and remains at least 4 feet high, and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards and to keep the fence gates closed when not in use.
