Finding

591-1-1-.17(8) requires staff to wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival for the day. when moving from one child care group to another, upon re-entering the child care area after outside play, before and after diapering each child, dispensing medication, applying topical medications, handling and preparing food, eating, drinking, preparing bottles, feeding each child, assisting children with eating and drinking, after toileting or assisting children with toileting, using tobacco products, handling garbage and organic waste, touching animals or pets, handling bodily fluids and after contamination by any means. It was determined based on observation that staff in building II did not wash their hands after cleaning a child's nose.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure liquid soap and warm running water are available for handwashing, train Staff on the handwashing requirements, review the requirements with Staff periodically, and monitor handwashing.

Finding

591-1-1-.32(2) requires the Center maintain Staff:child ratios in mixed-age groups based on the age of the youngest group of children that includes more than twenty percent of the total number of children in the mixed-age group. It was determined based on observation and staff statement that the following classrooms were out of ratio:

A- had a ratio of 1:11 nine children were one-year-olds and two children were two-years-old.

B- had a ratio of 1:14 with nine children two-years-old and five children three-years-old.

Building II- had a ratio of 1:7 six children were infants and one child was one-year-old.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will provide adequate staff when there is a mixed-age group and have substitutes for when staff are out.

Finding

591-1-1-.32(4) requires that children under three years old be housed in separate physical areas from older children and cannot be mixed with older children except at specified times and circumstances. It was determined based on observation and staff statements in classroom E there were nine two-year-old children and five three-year-old children mixed after the first hour of business.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will maintain separation of these children under three years old.
