#### **Comments**

An Administrative Review was conducted on December 15, 2020. Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. A virtual inspection was conducted on January 7, 2021 with the Director. The virtual insepction was rescheduled from December due to the school closing due to COVID-19. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive Order issued on August 15, 2020 was reviewed during the virtual inspection.

Consultant obesived one staff with 18 children age six and over in the computer lab, and two staff with 18 five year olds and six year olds and over in the cafeteria.

#### Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

<ul> <li>Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee</li> </ul>
