Comments

An Administrative Review was conducted on March 9, 2021. Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. A virtual inspection was conducted on March 11, 2021 with the Director. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive Order issued on February 15, 2021 was reviewed during the virtual inspection.

Consultant listed all present children in the cafeteria on the report. Consultant observed two staff and 35 children in the gym, one staff and 20 children transitioning in the hallway, one staff and 13 children at the bathroom, and two staff and 33 children transitioning from the playground.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
