591-1-1-.26(8) requires climbing and swinging equipment to have a resilient surface beneath the equipment and the fall zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency. It was determined based on consultant's observation there was one to three inches of woodchips under the large play structures and swings on the playground where six inches is required.

# POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will add additional resilient surfacing to the fall zones where needed and check daily, adding resilient surfacing as needed to maintain adequate resiliency.

Consultant suggests to dig up old dirt prior to putting new woodchips down to ensure woodchips stay within the boarders to assist with fall zones maintaining proper resiliency.
