

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Technical Assistance

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. The consultant discussed with the Director about ensuring that all fence bolts are cut to a minimum of two threads in length. Additionally, the consultant observed a small gap at the bottom of the fence and showed it to the Director so that it could be filled in.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that the following hazards were present on the playground and accessible to children in care.

-In the grassy area at the back of the older playground there was an active ant bed presenting a biting hazard. -On the Infant and toddler playground at the end of the gutters was a fibrous material that had washed off of the roof presenting a chocking hazard.

-On the Infant and toddler playground by the covered area at the bottom of the gutters on the ground are washed areas that allow for standing water after rain presenting a standing water hazard.

The center removed the fibrous material during the visit and treated the ant bed.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
